



In November, 2015, I decided I would commit to creating one mini fabric art piece per week for a year. I posted this announcement, along with the image of my first mini piece, on the FB Textile Arts page I belong to. Within hours, I had over 500 'likes' and expressions of interest from other artists who said they'd like to participate as well.

Thank you for your interest in 'Made on Monday'!

To participate in this little art challenge that grew, all you have to do is create one small piece of original two-dimensional art (5" x 5") each week for a year ... or, a minimum 12 pieces if 52 seem a bit daunting. Once you have one or two complete, you can submit your high res jpeg images to me and I will start building a page just for you on the 'Made on Monday' website and welcome you to the project on my FB page.

So, here's what I need in order to include you in this project. Asterisked items are required or your submission will not be accepted:

*1. At least 12 jpeg images of your 'Made on Monday' work. Size: 5" x 5", min. 180 dpi. Submit directly to me by e-mail or Dropbox if the files are too large. You may submit images as often as you wish, but your page will not be published until you've provided at least 12.

*2. A list of the images you have submitted that includes the following:

- titles of pieces if applicable
- the medium you work in
- if you are selling your work, please include the price (specify your currency and whether taxes and shipping are extra or included) and finishing details (i.e. stretched, framed, mounted, matted, printed, digital etc.)

*3. Your name.

*4. Your country and city/town.

5. *Optional*: a brief artist's statement (max. 200 words) plus artist photo.

*6. Your contact information so fans/customers can e-mail you directly.

7. *Optional*: links to your art website and/or Facebook page(s).

The small print:

The 'Made in Monday' website is an on-line gallery only. I am creating and managing this site for the fun of it and trust that all who choose to join do so in the same spirit.

I accept no responsibility for content or errors and trust that all work is original.

I do not facilitate sales (except of my own art) so any correspondence sent to me enquiring about you and your work will be forwarded directly to you.
